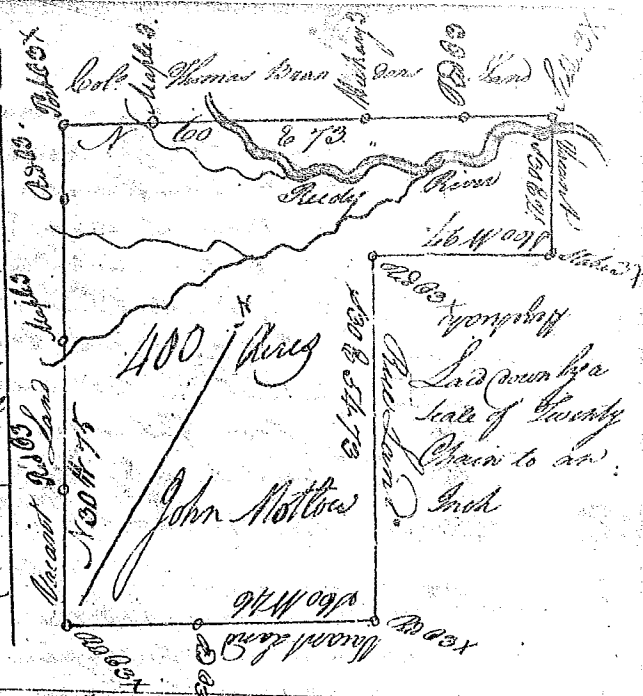


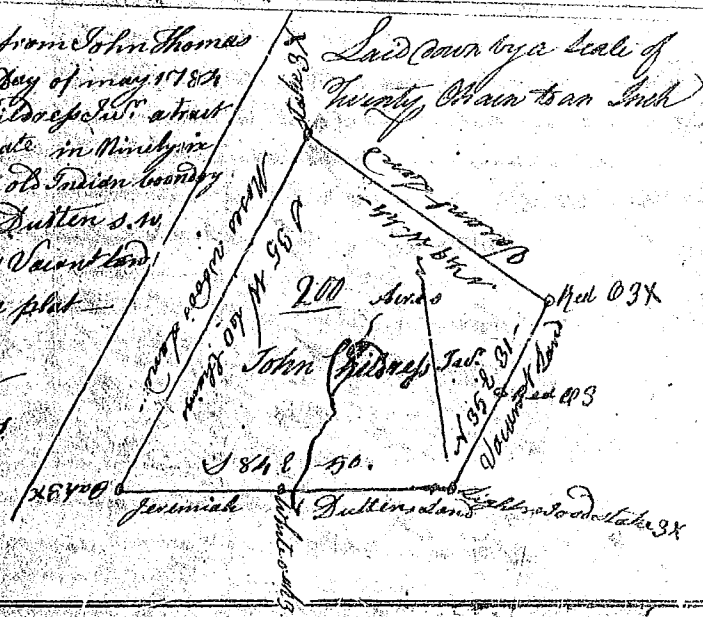

Commissioner of Locations dated the 21st day of May 1784 I have Admeasured and laid out unto John Childers Esq. a tract of Land containing two hundred acres situate in Ninety Six District on the N. side of Tupper River west of the Old Indian boundary bounding S & E on Land laid out for Jeremiah Dutton S.W. on Land laid out for Moses Wood, all other sides Vacant Land and hath such form and Marks, as the above plat represents
