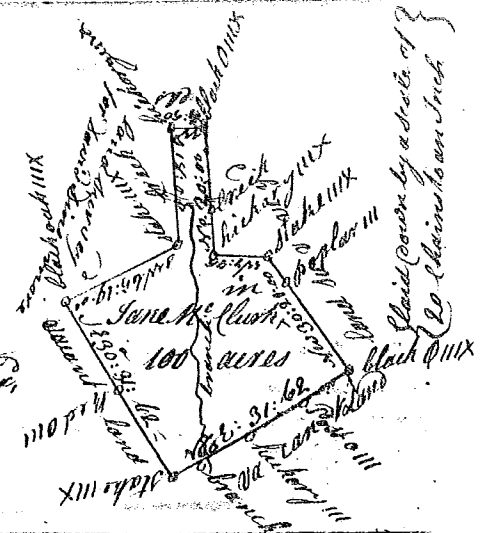

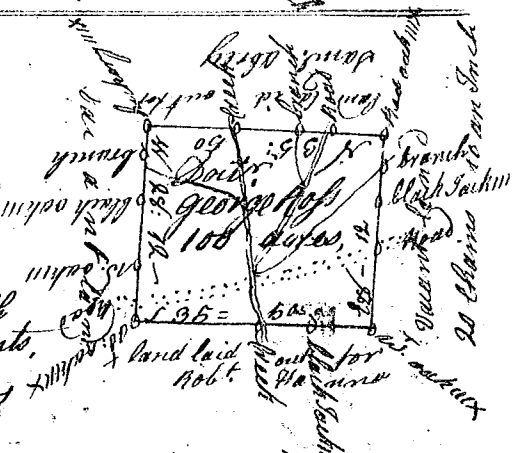

Glorin a tract of land containing one hundred acres on Summeys Creek in Ninety Six District Below the Indian Boundary Bounding west and so. on land laid out to David Dinsmore N. & E. on surveyed land all other sides on vacant land, and hath shape and Marks as the annexed Plat represents, *M. M. D. J.* the 15 July 1784 Recorded 6th Nov. 1784, — Robt. Hanna Esq.

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations in Ninety Six District No of Saluda River, dated 28 June 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto Doct. George Robt a tract of land containing one hundred acres on Duncans Creek below the Indian boundary, bounded E on land laid out for Samuel Aubrey, W on land laid out for Robert Hanna, all other sides on vacant land, and hath such shape and Marks as the annexed plat represents, *M.
