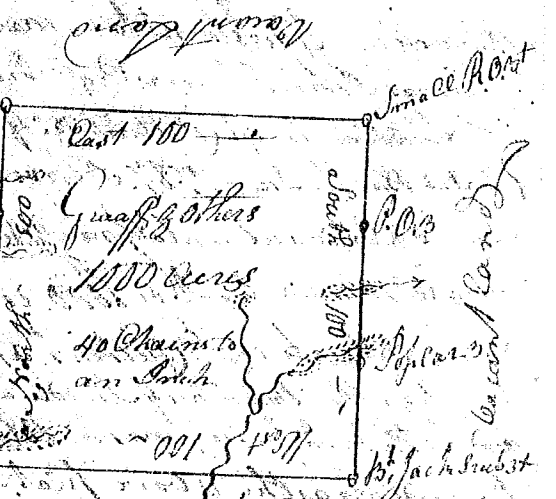


Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq^r Clerk

 line, all other sides vacant and hath
