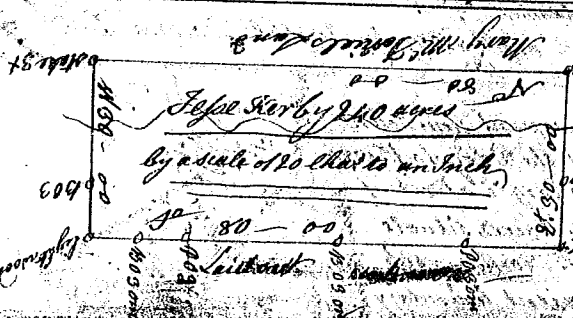
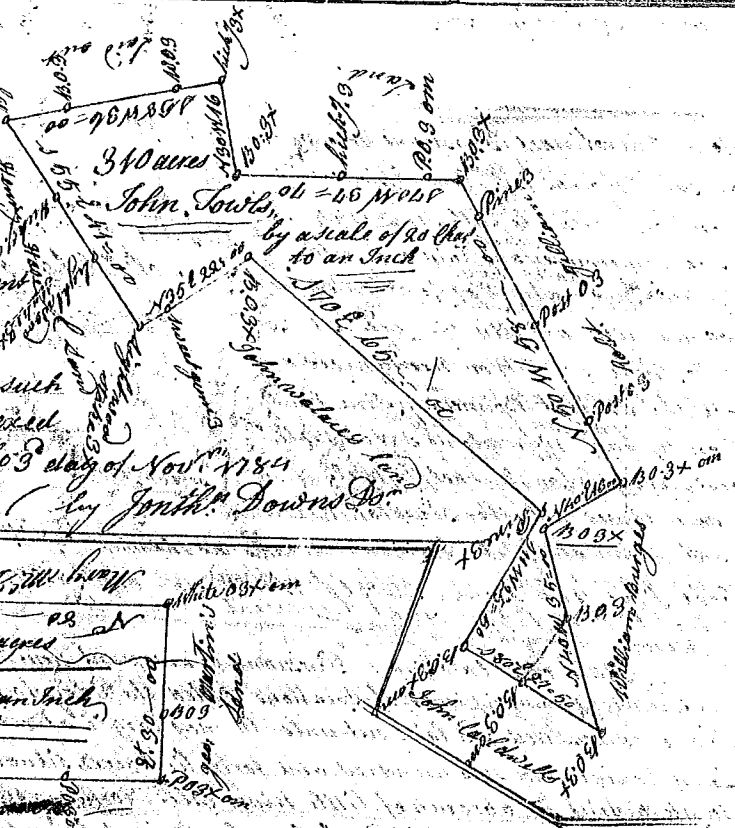


State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Ninety Six District

 Situate and lying on the South side of the Middle  
 Fork of Indian River bounded to the South by  
 Indian River all other sides Vacant Land & hath such  
 Shape & Marks as the above Plat Represents  
 Surveyed this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1784  
 Recorded the 15<sup>th</sup> febr<sup>y</sup> 1785

 Ninety six District on a branch  
 of Saluda River below the ancient  
 boundary line called Wallace  
 Branch, bounded all round  
 as above specified and hath such  
 Shape and Marks as the annexed  
 Plat Represents, Surveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1784  
 Recorded the 24<sup>th</sup> febr<sup>y</sup> 1785, (by John<sup>s</sup> Downs D<sup>r</sup>)



State of South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Commissioner of Location dated 17<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto Joseph Kerby two hundred and forty acres of land situate in 96<sup>th</sup> District on a branch of Sandy River called Mc Daniel's branch, above the ancient boundary line bounded N on Joseph Kellert's Land, S on George Martin's land W on land laid out unknown E on Mary M<sup>c</sup> Daniel's Land, and hath such Shape and Marks as the above Plat Represents, Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1784  
 Recorded the 25<sup>th</sup> febr<sup>y</sup> 1785, (by Rob<sup>t</sup> Hanna D<sup>r</sup>)

State of South Carolina 96<sup>th</sup> District Indian Land  
 Pursuant to a warrant from John  
 Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Commissioner of Location  
 dated 31 day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1784 I have admeasured  
 and laid out unto Reubin  
 Smith a tract of land containing  
 four hundred and eighty three and  
 lying on both sides of Hokey's creek  
 a branch of Enoree, bounded S by Joseph Woodall's land  
 all other sides Vacant Land, and hath such shape and  
 Marks as the above Plat Represents  
 Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1785  
 Recorded the 25<sup>th</sup> febr<sup>y</sup> 1785, (by del. Reubin Smith)
