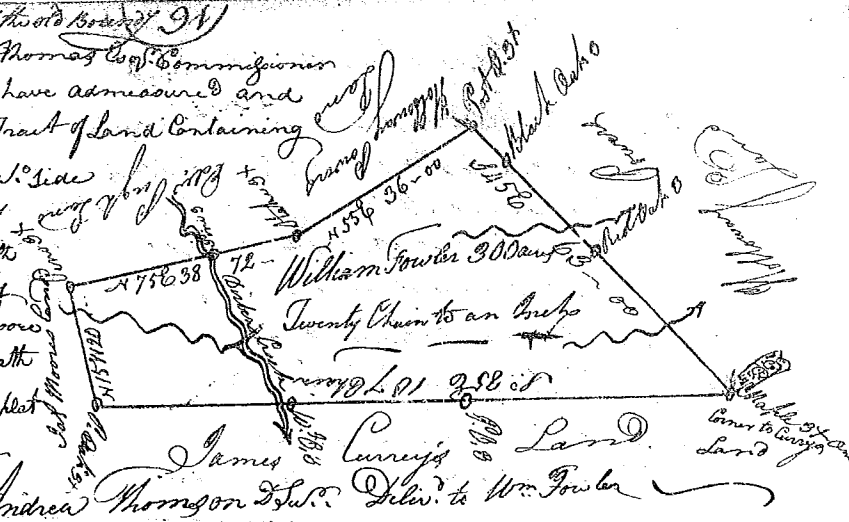
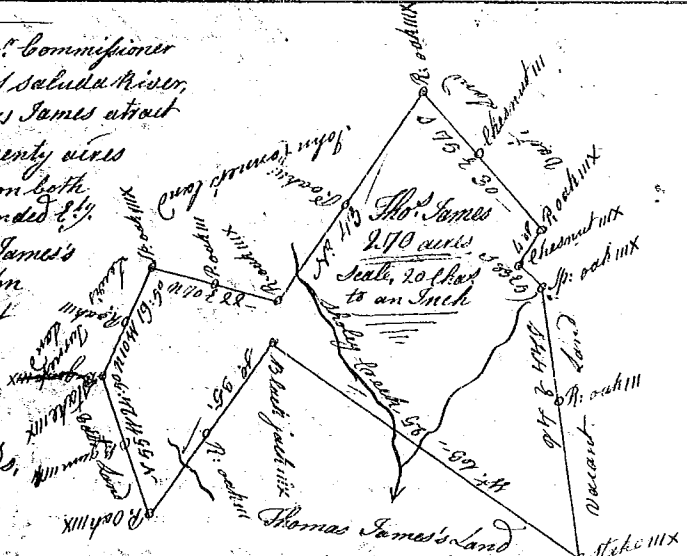


State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina 9<sup>th</sup> District East of the old boundary line

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Commissioner of Locations dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1784. I have admeasured and laid out unto William Fowler a Tract of Land containing Three Hundred acres lying on the S<sup>c</sup> side of Snow Creek & on both sides of Snow Creek bounded to the South by land laid out for James Curry W<sup>y</sup> by land laid out for James Moore N<sup>o</sup> 28<sup>th</sup> by Holloway Rivers land & hath such shape & marks as the above plat represents. Survey this 10<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1785

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Commissioner of Locations for the district of the S<sup>c</sup> side of Saluda River, I have surveyed and laid out unto Thomas James a tract of Land containing Two hundred and seventy acres situate below the ancient boundary line, on both sides of Shoey Creek of Laurin's Fork, bounded N<sup>o</sup> by John Bellinger's land S<sup>o</sup> by Thomas James's land W<sup>o</sup> by Lewis Turner's land & John Conner's land, on all other sides by Vacant Land, and has such shape and marks as the above Plat represents.

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Commissioner of Locations dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1784, I have admeasured & laid out unto Hugh Holland a Tract of Land containing Three Hundred & thirty two Acres situate lying & being on Buffalo Creek a branch of Sawford's, bounded to the South by Richard Rowntree's land to the East by Little's land all other sides Old lines & hath such shape & marks as the Annexed Plat represents
