



Recorded the 19th May 1785.



Recorded 19th May 1785.




State of S<sup>t</sup> Carolina, 96 District,

Tract of Land the N<sup>E</sup> of Saluda River, situate lying  
and being on a branch of Rocky field Creek, water  
of Enoree River & bounded southerly by William  
Willox's land and bounded on all other sides  
on Vacant Land and hath such Shape form  
and marks as the above Plat Represents
