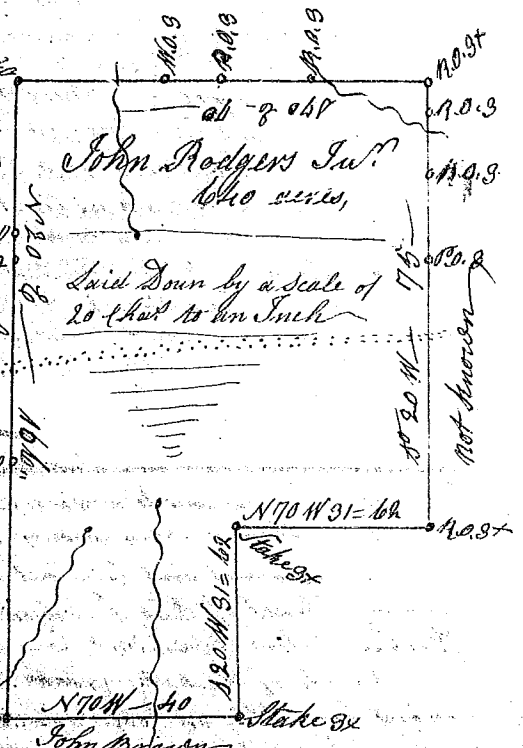
Pursuant to a warrant dated 9th of June

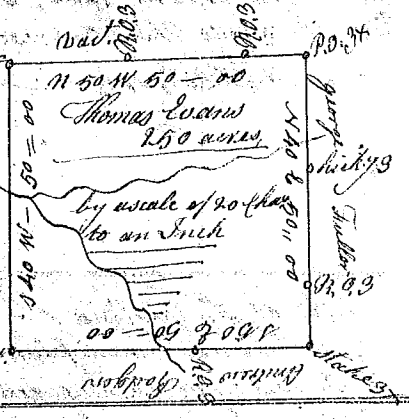


State of South Carolina, Pursuant to a
