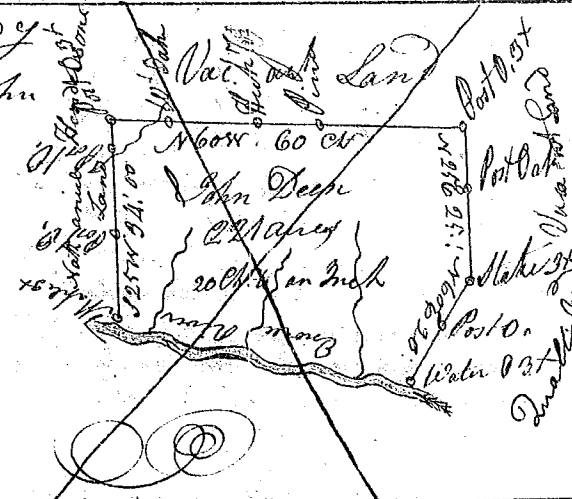

I have admeasured & laid out unto Moses Boiter a tract of land containing one hundred & fifty eight acres, situated lying & being on the small branches of Sygar River. Bounded N. by J. J. by 80.00. Duncans land W. by Joseph Allens land & all other sides by Varant's Land & both such shape form & marks as the annexed plat represents. Surveyed this the 18th August 1785 by James Wilford Esq^r. Recorded this 5th day of Sept^r 1785. D^o.

I have admeasured & laid out unto John Neal a tract of land containing five hundred & six acres, situated lying & being in Spartansburg County on the S. side of Pacolet spruce River. On a small branching Call^d the Trough Shoal branch waters of Pacolet River, of both such shape marks & boundaries as the annexed Plat represents. Surveyed this 13th Sept^r 1785.
