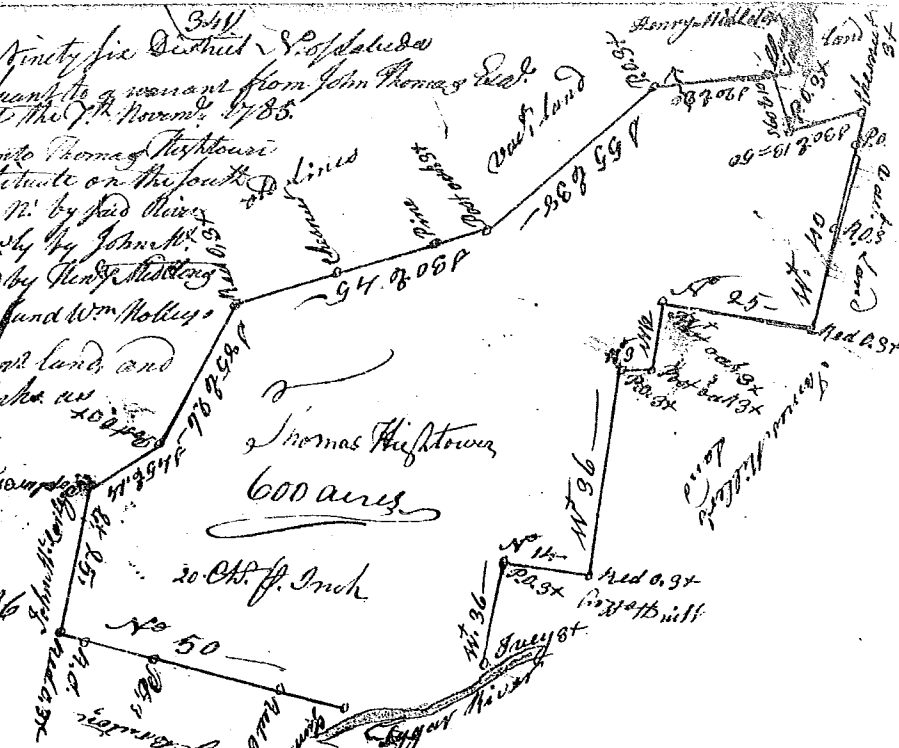


State of South Carolina, Ninety six District of Saluda
