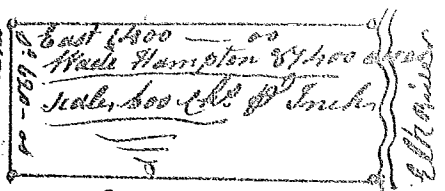


State of S^c Carolina

This 11th of Feby. 1786 by virtue of a warrant to me directed have surveyed for waste Hampton Co. 87,400 acres of land on the N.W. side of Elk river, bounded as follows viz^t. beginning at several trees on

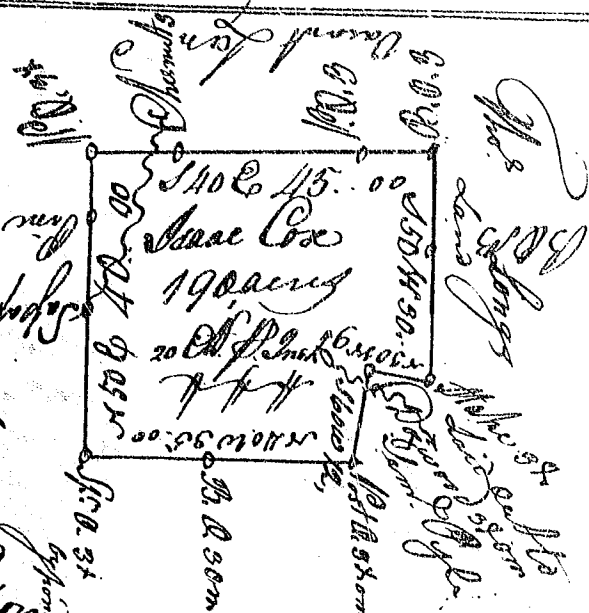


river bank marked with the initials of several Persons names, above the mouth of Indian Creek, where the 35th degree of N. latitude crosses said river. Thence W. 5600 Poles to a stake artificially set up, thence N. 2500 Poles, to sundry marked trees, thence East 5600 Poles to a corner on Elk river aforesaid, thence down the same as it meanders to the first station, — Recorded 28th feby. 1786. W. John Donelson D.

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq^r Es^p (dated the 2nd May 1786) I have admeasured & laid out unto Isaac Cox a tract of land containing 190 Acre, Situate in

96 district above the ancient boundary. to the N.E. side of Rocky River, on a branch thereof called Cox's branch, & that such shape four buttings & boundaries as the above plat represents.
