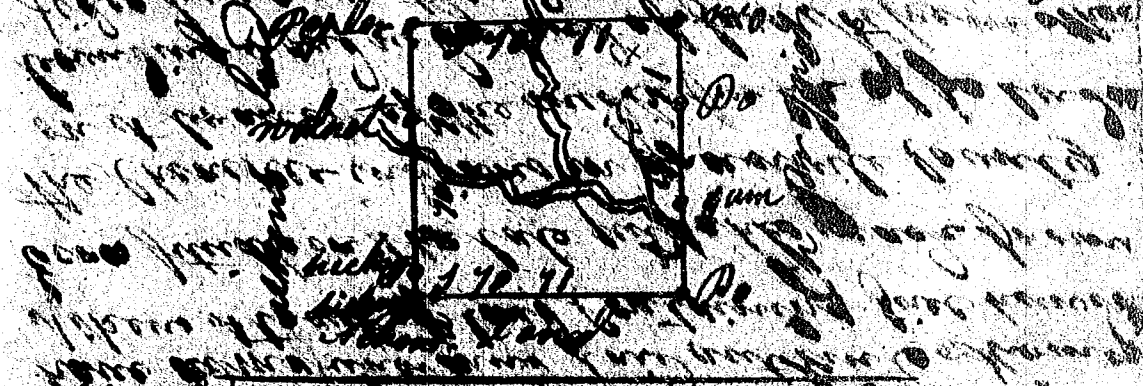


South Carolina pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas
