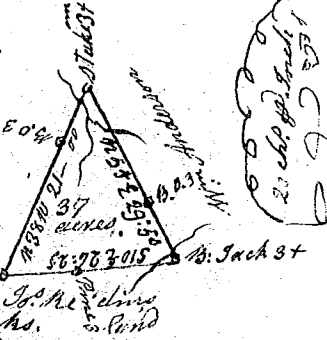

 as the above Plat represents



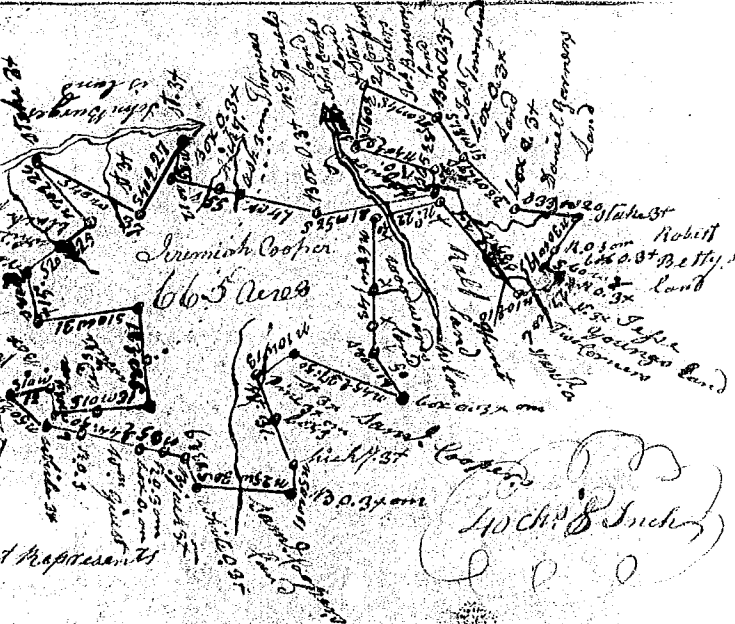
