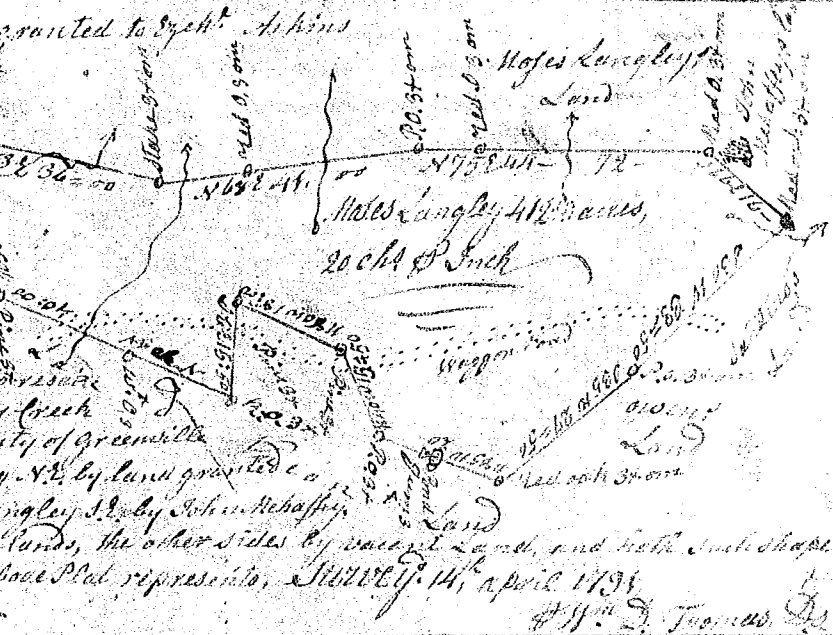


State of South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations Dated the 6th day of July 1791. I have admeasured and laid out unto William Thomas a tract of twenty eight acres of land in Greenville County on a small branch of Saluda river, bounded by a line running S 20 W by land laid out for Adam Clayton, S 20 W by a line running N 70 E by land laid out for Thomas Blasingame, N 70 E by a line running N 45 W by land laid out for James Thomas Clayton and hath such shape and marks as the above Plat represents, Surveyed 7th July 1791. State of South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations Dated 17th Aug. 1791. I have admeasured and laid out unto David & Mc Dowell a tract of two hundred and fifty acres of land situate in 9th District in Spartanburg County on the branches of Kawoos, fork and Pacolet river - Bounded N on said Mc Dowell land, N 8 W on west land, S 8 E on land laid out for James Mc Dowell, and hath such shape, form & marks as the above Plat represents. Surveyed 27th Aug. 1791. John Young Esq. Recorder 19th Sept 1791.



State of S^c Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations in 9th District & situated on the river dated 18th April 1791. I have admeasured and laid out unto Moses Langley a tract of four hundred & twelve acres of land, in the District aforesaid on the south fork of Neasey Creek of Nox river in the County of Greenville Bounding by lines running N 72 E by land granted to Esq. H. H. H. & Moses Langley, S 8 E by Sanders & Kearsy's lands, the other sides by vacant land, and hath such shape form and marks as the above Plat represents. Surveyed 14th April 1791. Recorder 20th Sept 1791.



State of S^c Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Comm^r of Loc^s Dated 11th day of Dec^r 1790. I have admeasured and laid out unto John Forrester a tract of one hundred and twenty acres of land in Greenville County on both sides of the Meadow fork of Bush Creek waters of Tygar river, Bounded by a line running S 38 W by land held by Bayles Esq. Esq. by a line running N 19 W by land laid out for Lowrey, all other sides by vacant land & hath such shape and marks as the above Plat represents. Surveyed 22nd Dec^r 1790. George Salmon Esq. Recorder 22nd Sept 1791.
