 the river, then down the river to the first station

 Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> Decr 1791.

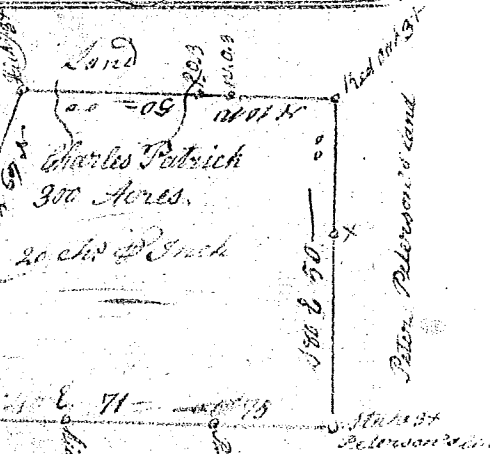
