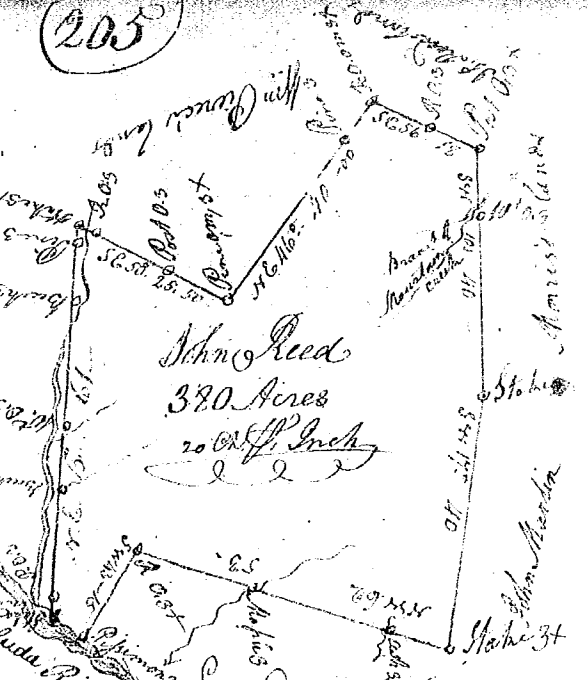

E. & S. by Joseph & Reeds & Duncy's, Mountland's & W. by land Originally granted to John Martin & hath such shape and marks as the above Plat represents.
