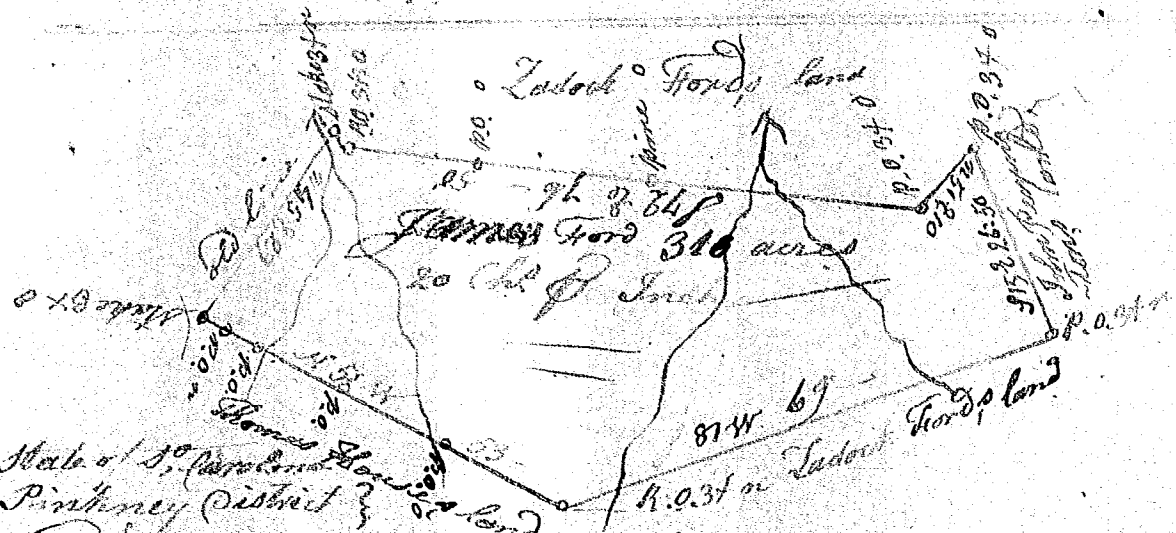

I have laid out unto James Ford a tract of three hundred and ten acres of land in Spartanburg County on another bank waters of Snowe river, bounding with land N. & E. line, N.W. with Thomas House, S.W. with Ladock Ford S.E. with John Pennington's N.E. S.E. with Ladock Ford's land and with such slope and matches as the above plot represents —
