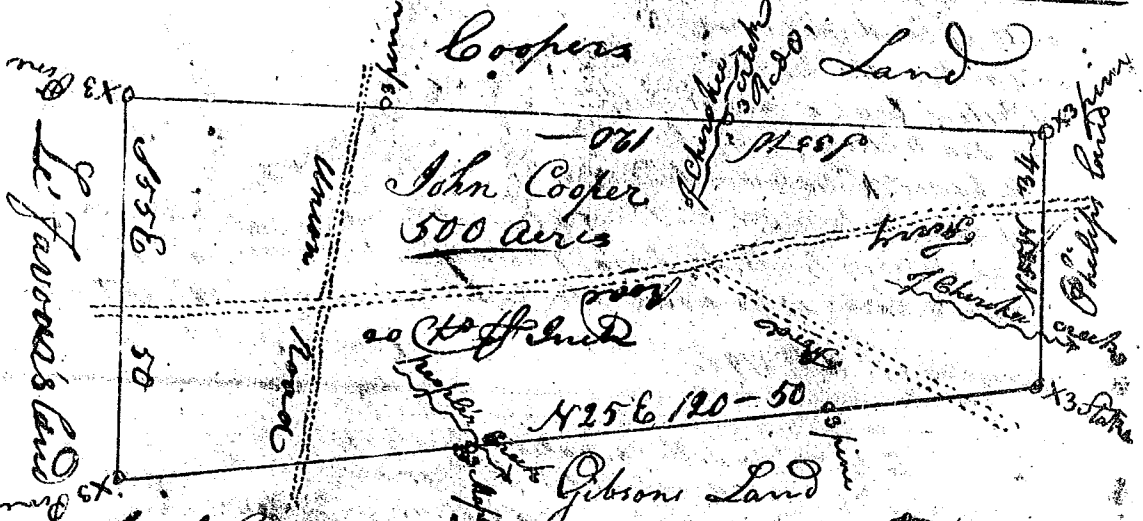


Spartanburg County

South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. of the N^o side of Broad river dated 4th Oct. 1798 I have surveyed for John Cooper a tract of 500 acres lying in the County of Spartanburg, on the waters of Cherokee, & Peoples Creeks, branches of Broad river, bounded on the N.W. by John Cooper's land, on the N.E. by Phillips Land & by Gibson's land & on the S.W. by land belonging to Le Favours, & both sides of marks, according to the above plat represents Survey the 19th Oct. 1798
