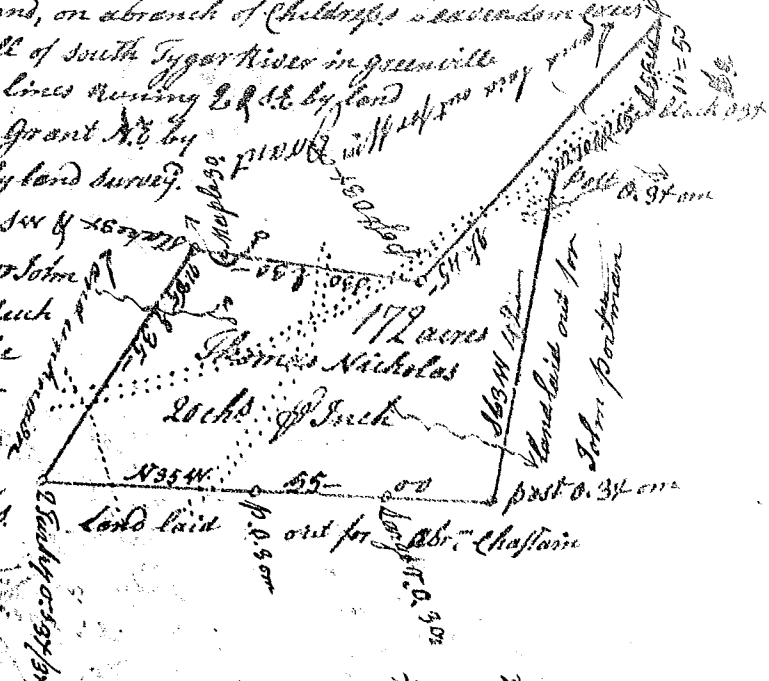


State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas

 17<sup>th</sup> Sept<sup>r</sup> 1798, I have admeasured and  
 laid out unto Abraham Chastain a tract  
 of two hundred acres of land, on branches  
 of South Tyger River in Greenville County  
 bounded by lines running NW & S by  
 Abr<sup>m</sup> Chastain land SE by land survey  
 for Thomas Nicholas N<sup>e</sup> N<sup>W</sup> by land  
 unknown NE by Duncan Wilkinson  
 land, and hath such shape & marks  
 as the above plat represents.
