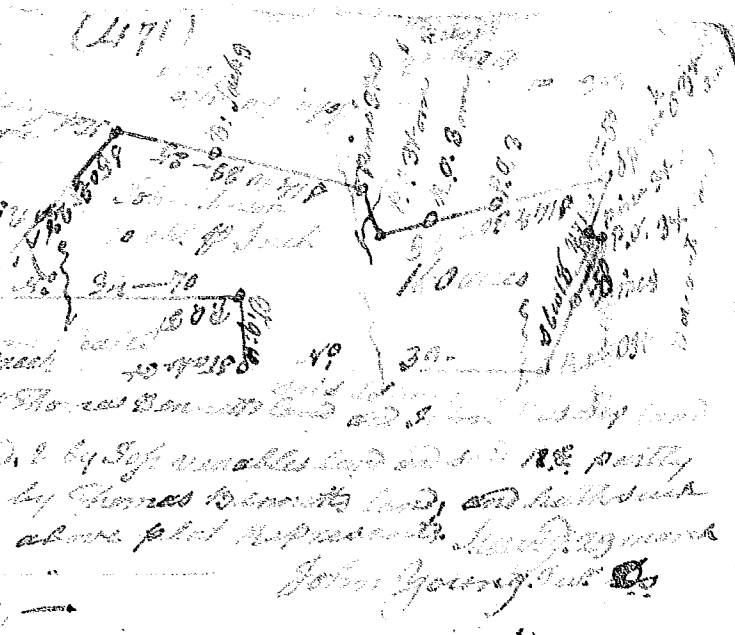
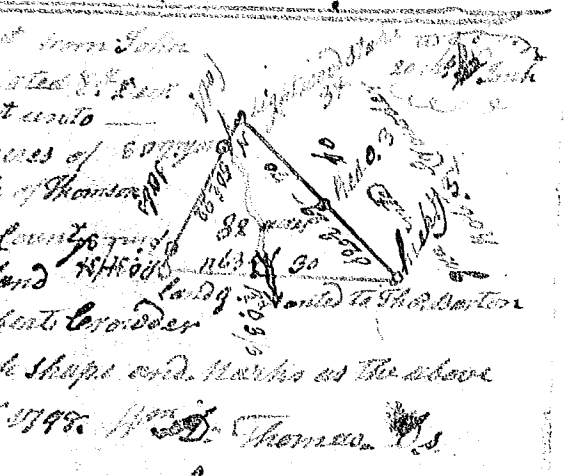


South Carolina Pursuant to agreement from John
