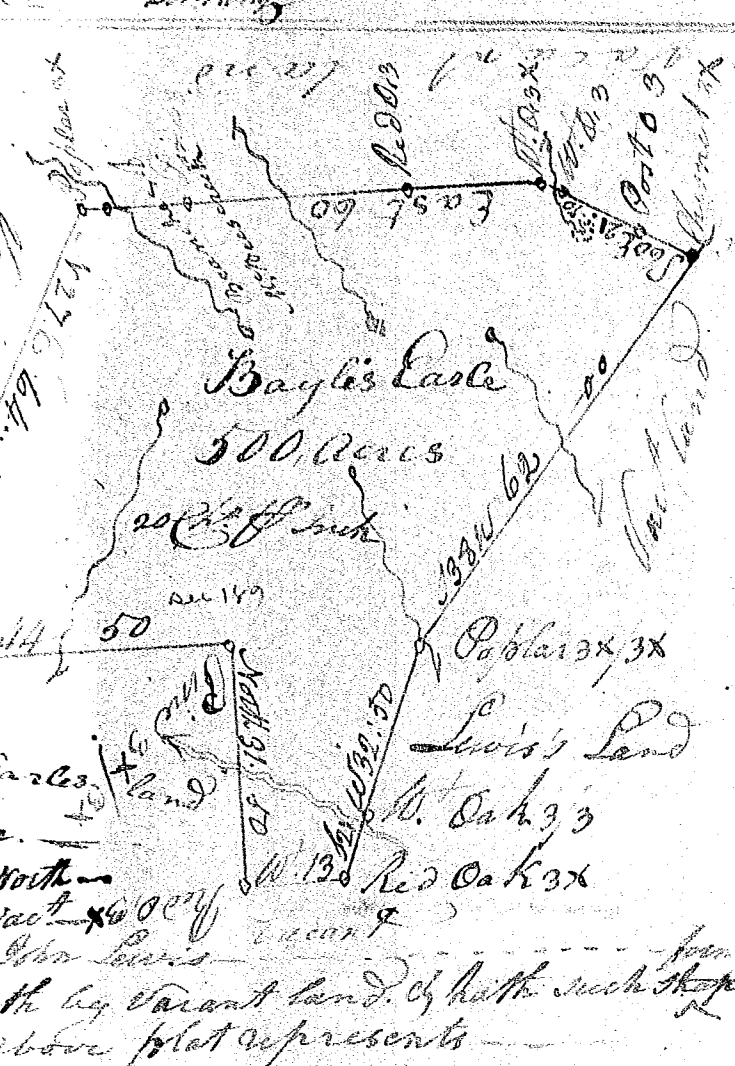


South Carolina. Pickens District
