Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Com<sup>r</sup> of Locations N<sup>o</sup> 1000 dated the 2<sup>d</sup> May 1795 I have admeasured & laid out unto Richard Drake a tract of One hundred & Ten acres of Land in Union County on the S<sup>th</sup> Side of Four Forest on the Small Branches of S<sup>d</sup> Creek bounded Southward by William Darbys Land and hath such other Boundaries Shape and Marks as the above plat Represents

Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795
