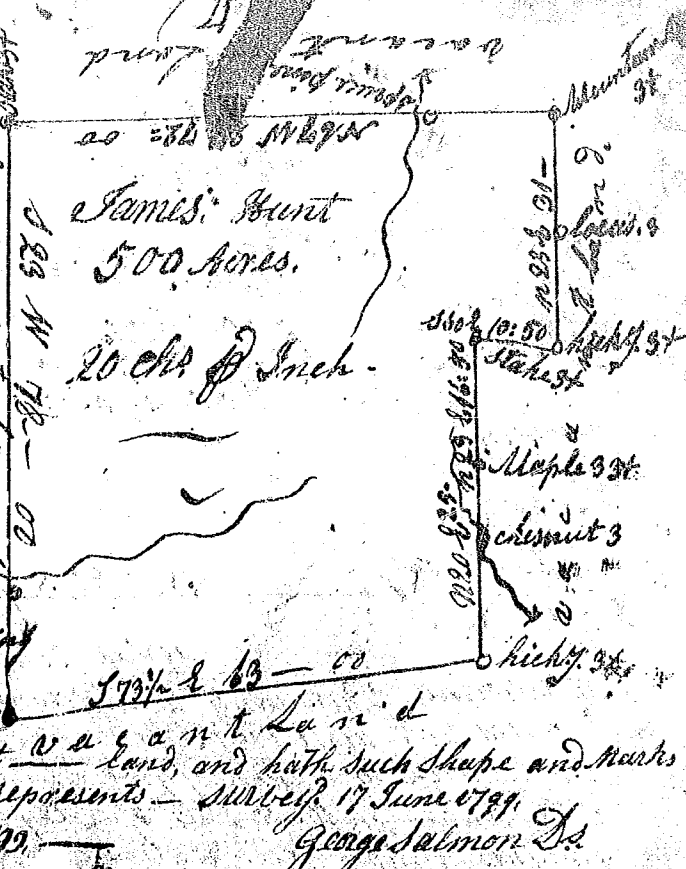


South Carolina

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas, Esq. Comr. of locat. N. Carolina dated 15<sup>th</sup> June 1799 I have admeasured and laid out unto James Hunt a tract of five hundred acres of land in greenville County on both sides of a small branch of Slicking Creek water of Saluda River. Including some of the branches of Camp Creek, bounded on all sides by vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as the above plot represents - surveyed 17 June 1799. Recorded 5<sup>th</sup> Augt. 1799.

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas, Esq. Comr. of locat. N. Carolina dated 15 June 1799. I have admeasured and laid out unto Henry Bradford a tract of five hundred acres of land in greenville County on both sides of a small branch of Big Creek or gibbon Creek bounded on all sides by land laid out for George Salmon on other sides by vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as the above plot represents - surveyed 18<sup>th</sup> June 1799. Recorded 5<sup>th</sup> Augt. 1799.
