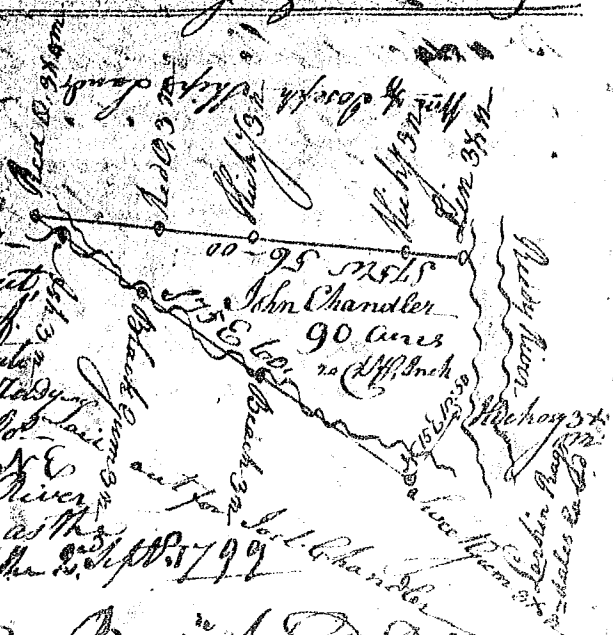

Cobbs Land Vacant Land and by John Youngs Land N. wardly by Vacant Land N.W. wardly by Land laid out for Joseph Dennis and Vacant Land S.W. wardly by Land laid out for Jesse Mansfield and both such Shapes & Marks as the above plat represents
