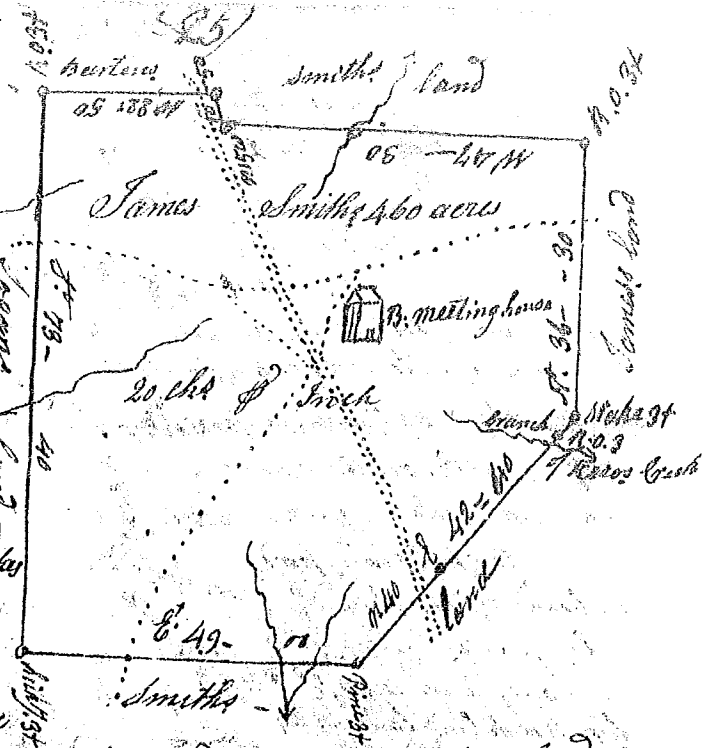


South Carolina
