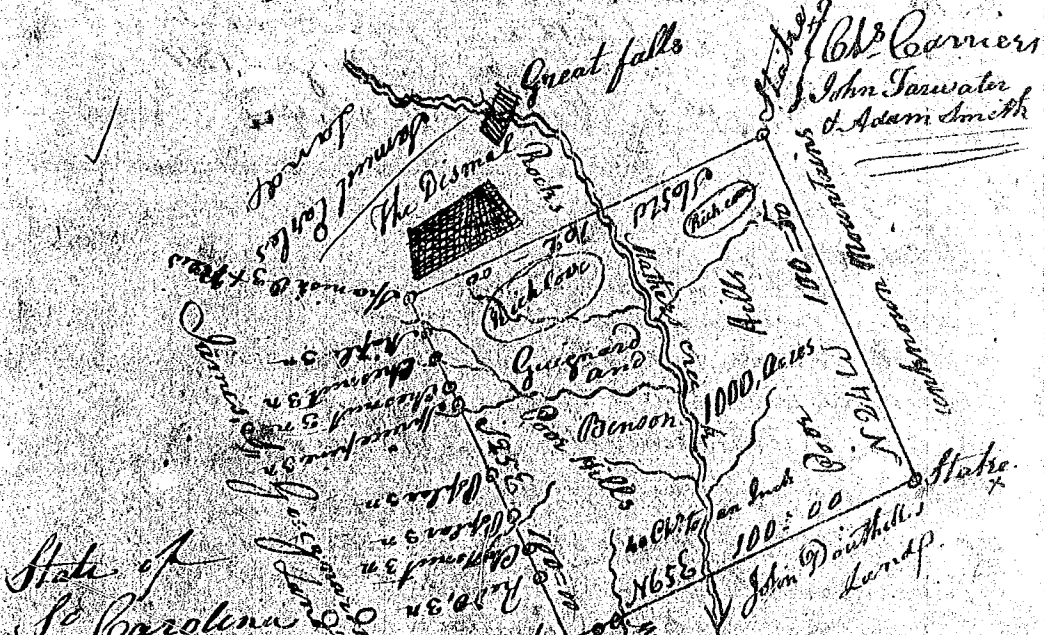
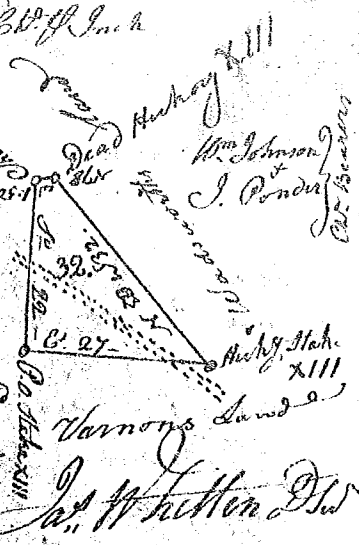


S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Pursuant to a (66) 206<sup>th</sup> Inch

Warrant from Com<sup>o</sup> D<sup>o</sup> Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Com<sup>o</sup> Lot. in the district of Greenville Dated the 1<sup>st</sup> June 1811. I have admeas<sup>d</sup> & laid out unto John Beidler a tract of land containing thirty two acres situate in said District, on both sides of the ridge road, between the Beaver Dam & Tappan River: Bound by a line every 20 by land laid out for Tho<sup>s</sup> Beeson, E<sup>t</sup> by land laid out for James Vernon N<sup>o</sup> by land granted to Wadsworth & Ferguson, & hath such holes and marks as the above plat represents. Survey<sup>d</sup> the 18<sup>th</sup> June 1811. Recorded the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1811.



Pursuant to a warrant from Com<sup>o</sup> D<sup>o</sup> Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> Com<sup>o</sup> Lot. for Greenville dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May 1811. I have admeasured & laid out unto James S. Quigward and Gabriel Beeson one thousand acres of land situate in the district of Greenville, on Mathews's Creek of the 1<sup>st</sup> fork of Saluda River, bounded by a line bounded to the said J<sup>s</sup> Quigward's land N<sup>o</sup> by John Dobbins's land N<sup>o</sup> by Unknown Mountains, & N<sup>o</sup> by Samuel Charles land & hath such form & marks as the above plat represents. Survey<sup>d</sup> the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1811.
