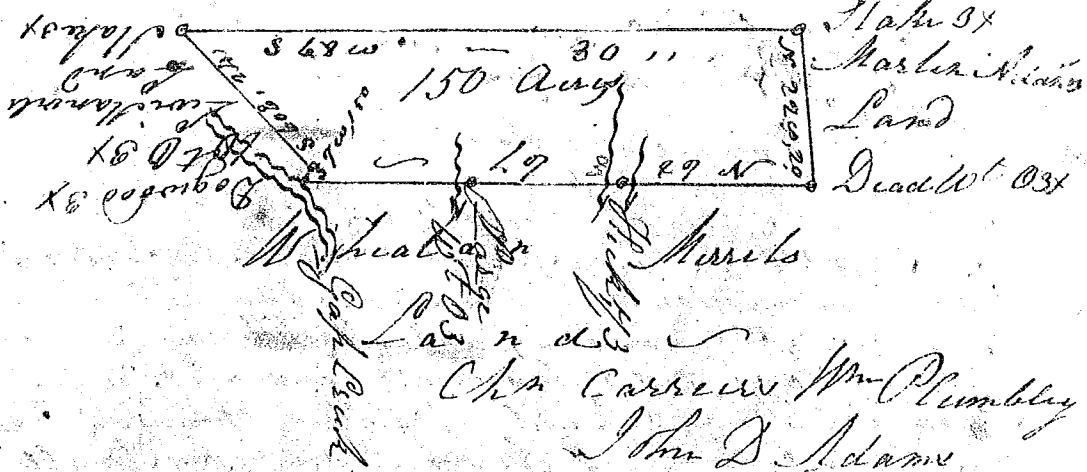

Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esqr, Commr of Locations for the District of Greenville, dated the 27 day of September 1817, I have admeasured & laid out unto Martin Adams a tract of one hundred and fifty acres of Land situate in the District aforesaid, on branches of Cherokee of Saluda River, Bounded by a line running NW by sd Martin Adams Land N E by Wheaters Murlets, SE by Levi Manciles Land & also by vacant Land and with such form & marks as the above Plat represents,
