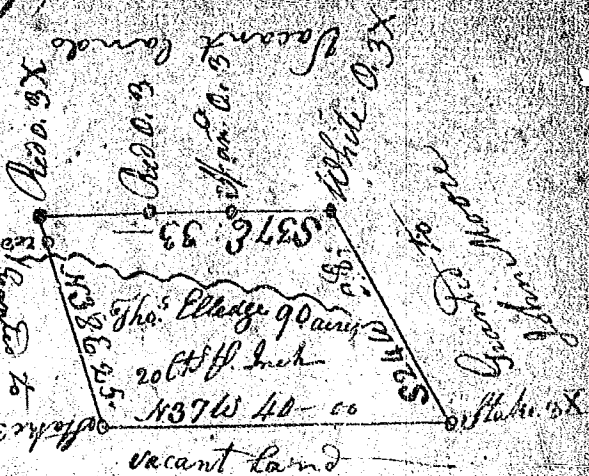

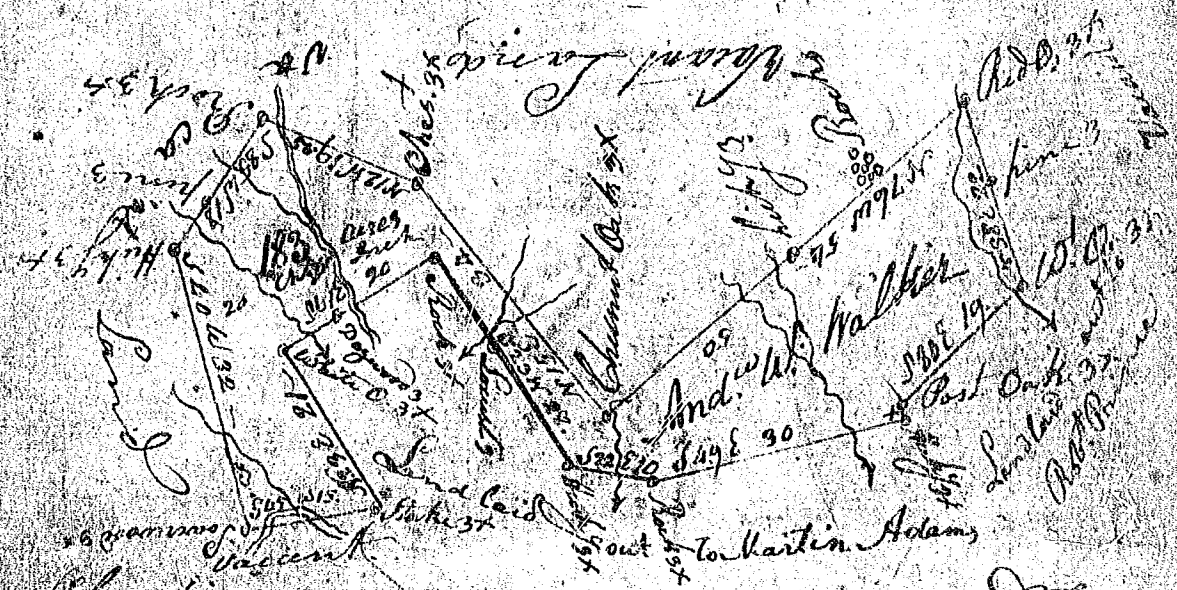
Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. C. L. dated the 14th day of Nov. 1803

Pursuant to a Warrant from W. D. Thomas Esq. C. L. in Greenville Dist. dated the 28th March 1804

I have administered and put unto Andrew W. Walker a tract of One Hundred of Eighty three acres of land, situated in Parish of Beaufort on both sides Beaufort creek, of Chesapeake river, waters of James River. bounded by lines running N. E. S. E. S. W. & N. W. by land granted to Martin Adams N. E. by land laid out to Robert Prime & Co. all the other sides by vacant land. of both such shape & marks as the above plat represents. Survey'd the 28th March 1804
