 administered and laid out unto the Patterson a
 tract of three hundred and ninety seven acres of land

 and on both sides of Greenville Road, Bounded East-
 wardly by Lines Running N 50° W by Ferguson and Bruce
 Lands, Westwardly by a Branch of Line Running
 N 50° W, by Edwards, Sloan and Mountgomerys Lands
 Northwardly & Eastwardly by Line running N 72°
 N 78° E and S 58° E by Sloans Land, and Land Occupy-
 ed by Moor, Slack and Co. and has such form
 and marks as the above Plat Expresseth
 Sheweth the 3rd day of Decr 1823.
