Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esq Commr of Locations for Greenville district created the 15th day of April 1831, I have admeasured and laid out unto said Picklet a tract of land containing seven hundred and nineteen acres, situate in said district, on Branches waters of the North fork of Saluda River. Bounded by lines running N E East and S E by Tho's Blythe's Land N E by Jesse Trammels Land, and N W & S E by Land surveyed for Henderson, and Col. John Hodge and S W by said Jas Picklet's Land. And hath such form and marks as the above plat represents. Surveyed the 27th day of April 1831.
