Pursuant to a warrant from John Young, Esq. Comptroller of the District of Greenville dated the 10th day of Jan'y 1832, I have advertised and laid out unto Adam Jones a tract of land containing 139 Acres situate in said District on a small branch of the Reddy Fork of Reddy River, bounded by said branch on the N.E. & N.W. on Williams' N.E. on D & J Sullivan and the Smith, being composed of part of two tracts originally surveyed, that shaded pink with for Casey, and that shaded ~~pink~~ yellow for John Connor & a small proportion vacant, and both such maps as the above Plat. Represents surveyed for the purpose of obtaining a new Grant, the 14th day of Jan'y 1832. — G. Seaborn J. R. Heard the 6th day of Feb'y 1832. — by John Young, Esq. handed to self.
