 dated the 4th day of April A.D. 1831. I have advertised and laid out unto C. C.
 John Ridge a tract of land containing four thousand seven hundred and eighty
 nine acres situate in said district, on both sides of the North fork of the
 river and branch waters of Tiger River; bounded by Lewis Kump's land N. E. by
 Hightower and South Goodwin's land, S. E. by Alfred Hightower's land, S. W. by
 Ballahan's land, N. W. by B. W. Whittaker, adjacent to C. C. Dumbham's land S. W.
 N. E. by the Grammel and James Pickett's land and unknown lands, its being a
 relocation of former Grants, and hath such corners and marks as the above is
