

South Carolina

Pursuant to a Warrant from William Blount Esq. (Governor) in and to the District of Beaufort, with date the first day of August 1843 I have advertised and laid out into Roger Lowland Esq. a tract of eight hundred and twenty one acres of land situate in the said District on the sides of Beavers Creek waters of South Paolok River and bounded by lines running N 74 by Nathan Wards Land S. E. S. W.) N 74 by Malins share South by Richard Butters Land S. E. & South by Beavers and Malins shares Land N. E. & S. E. by Wm's Barnetts land including a part of an old grant to Richard Drayle and also some parcels of land adjoining never before granted. The object of this survey being to obtain a new grant for the whole by ransoming the old and including the new in the same grant the whole having been found and marks settings and boundings as the above parties represent.
