Pursuant to a Warrant from Robt. M^r Ray, Esq. Commissioner of Locations in the District of Columbia, dated the 15th day of April, 1844, I have admeasured and laid out unto Daniel Hanison, a Tract of Land containing One hundred and Twenty-One Acres, situate in said District, on both sides of Vaughn's Creek, waters of North Paclet River, bounded by lines running N. W. by Joseph Embury, Hites and Manhalls Land, South by said Hanison's, S. E. and S. W. by Maty Fisher and Robin M^r Chas land, and N. E. by James M^r Chas land, and having such form and marks as the above Plat represents.
