until paid in full, all interest not paid to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten* dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind, of which is secured under this mortgage, as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *George D. Eubank*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, fronting on the west side of Calhoun street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: beginning at a stake on said Calhoun street ninety-five feet from the north west corner of Calhoun and the Call streets, thence along Calhoun street N. 69 3/4 W. forty-nine feet to stake; thence N. 30 1/4 W. twenty and one-half feet to stake; thence S. 69 3/4 W. forty-nine feet to the beginning corner on Calhoun street, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Mattie D. Walker by deed dated Sept. 8, 1911 and recorded in D.M. Office for said County in Vol. #13, at page 422.
