the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

All that piece, ~~parcels~~ or lot of land being known as lot # 13 in Block # 10 on the map of "Sterling Annex" recorded in vol. 20 of Plats at page 9, in R. M. C. Office for said County; said "Sterling Annex" being a subdivision of property of Thomas F. Parker. The lot herein described has the following metes and bounds: beginning at an iron pin in the southwest line of the Sterling School Property (this point of beginning being the northwest corner of Mims and Sterling Sts); thence with Mims st. S. 47-45 W. sixty-eight and two-tenths (68.2) feet to an iron pin, this point being the northeast corner of lot # 12; thence with line of last mentioned lot N. 44-50 W. one hundred forty-nine and ~~70~~ (149.7) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-45 E. one hundred and twenty (120) feet to an iron pin in line of Sterling School Property; thence with last mentioned line S. 25-15 E. one hundred and fifty-eight (158) feet to the beginning corner.
