computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by this note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal process of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Ella Mauldin, all that lot or parcel of land near the City

of Greenville in the State and County aforesaid, on the Hampton Avenue Extension and on the west side of the right-of-way of the Southern Railway Company near the Over-head bridge and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner on the north side of the Public Road and running thence south 73-3/4 east 200 feet to an iron pin on the north side of the fill at west end of the over-head bridge thence north 19 East 80 feet to an iron pin; thence North 73-3/4 West 2 00 feet to an im pin in the east side of a road; thence with the east line of the road south 19 West 80 feet to the beginning point, containing thirty-six hundredths (36/100) of an acre and being the lot conveyed to us by Alvin H. Dean and conveyed to him by J. Lee Green and to him by C.J. Jeffrey.
