computed and paid Annually

until paid in full; if interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of amount due

upon said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

in the State and County aforesaid, near Roper Mount-
ain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Pack King,
John Cole and others, being a part of a sixty-
five (65) acre tract of land purchased by W. W.
Green from J. M. Chandler, and recorded in R. M. C.
office for Greenville County in Deed Book Volume
"54", page 726, dated Dec. 17th. 1875, and having the
following metes and bounds to wit: beginning
on iron pin in road thence N. 21 W. 4.81 chs. to
N. O. thence N. 7 E. 77 links to iron pin in branch,
thence down the branch N. 36-3/4 W. 2.24 chs. to
stone; thence N. 45 E. 1.88 to stone; thence N. 45-1/2
W. 2.00 chs. to stone; thence N. 41 W. 10.00 chs. to stone;
