WHEREAS, we, the said G. W. Vaughan and W. Maurice Vaughan
in and by our certain note in writing, of
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of one thousand
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from September 10th 1918 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of amount
due on said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and
County aforesaid on Augusta and Elkin streets
and having the following meter and bounds to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of Augusta
street and Elkin street, and running thence with
Elkin street 79 feet to an iron pin, thence with
an angle to the left 80 1/2 degree 19 1/2 feet to an
iron pin, thence with an angle to the left 100
degrees, seventy nine and one fourth (79 1/4)
feet to an iron pin on Augusta street, thence
with Augusta street 20 feet to the beginning
corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me
by George Brounlee, also all other piece parcel
or tract of land situate lying and being in the
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, in
Fourth Township and on Reedy River and contain-
ing one hundred and seven (107) acres, more or
less, and having such meter and bounds appear
