SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said W. M. Woods

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, dated
July 6th. 1918 with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Two hundred fifty Eight & 29/100
Dollars, to be paid as stated in said note, Oct. 1st. 1918

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said W. M. Woods

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said W. A. Chandler

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. A. Chandler, all that lot of land

situate on Thruston street in Ward six of the City
of Greenville County of Greenville and in the State
of South Carolina, having the following metes
and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe
seventy-nine and 4/10 feet from the corner of
Thruston and Howe streets and running thence
with Thruston street S. 65.25 W. 60 feet to an iron
pipe; thence S. 23.05 E. 207.1 feet to an iron pipe;
thence with line of George Thruston's property
N. 64-30 E. 55 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 21.38
W. 206.2 feet to the beginning corner, being a
portion of the lot conveyed to me by J. L. Green
by his deed dated June 28th. 1918 and said
deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for
Greenville County in Vol. 42 at page 459.
