bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. T. Burnell, The Peoples' National Bank, of Greenville,

all that certain piece, parcel, and lot of land, situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid about five miles above Greenville City on the East side of the Burdcombe road, being a part of a 25 1/2 acre tract of land purchased by W. F. Henderson and J. E. Stewart by deed dated 24th Nov. 1914 and recorded in Vol. 26 page 406, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on stone 3207 on Hawkins and Henderson corner, thence 3.75 1/4 N. 6.13 to stone on Burdcombe road; thence up the center of the said road as a line S. 6 1/4 E. 17.00 to stake, thence 71.54 1/2, E. 10.37 to iron tier, thence 71.54 1/2 N. 4.17 to the beginning corner containing four acres more or less. This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J. E. Stewart on Sept. 30th. 1918.
