interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may

sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on President Street near Furman University in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid and having the following described metes and bounds to wit: beginning at the south western corner of Prof. W. F. Watson's line; and running thence 50 N. wistly (60) feet to a stake; thence S. 3 1/2 E. Two Hundred and eleven (211) feet more or less to a stake at corner of Prof. G. B. Moore's lot; thence north sixty (60) feet along Prof. G. B. Moore's line to the south eastern corner of Prof. Watson's line; thence along Prof. Watson's line N. 84 W. two hundred and four (204) feet to the beginning corner.
