sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *five per cent of the
amount due upon said note* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..... reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

J. E. Watson according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *J. E. Watson*, the said

J. E. Watson in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. E. Watson*
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. E. Watson*

all that certain parcel or tract of land situate
lying and being in Butler Township, County and
State aforesaid and having the following lines and
bounds, to-wit: Beginning on stone in Rocky
Creek (Water Oak cuttings); thence N. $68\frac{3}{4}$ W. 4.90
to stone at branch; thence N. $15\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.42 to Leon
Pine; thence S. $43\frac{1}{2}$ W. 21.27 to Leon Pine (Alec
Forrest's line); thence S. 42 E. 16.50 to small Poplar
at Creek; thence lower meanders of Creek, N. $4\frac{1}{4}$
E. 20.75 to the beginning point, containing thirty
acres, more or less, and being the same tract of
land, conveyed to me by *J. E. Watson*.
