WHEREAS, we, the said Revs. J. R. George, J. L. Keeley, W. D. Correll,
R. C. Hendrick and W. W. Davis as trustees of the S. C. Wesleyan Methodist Association
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of

even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of, \$ 100.00
Dollars, to be paid as follows, Two Hundred and Thirty Dollars on
or before October 1st 1919, and two Hundred and
Twenty Five Dollars on or before October 1st 1920
with interest thereon from September 10th 1918 at the rate of 4 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Trustees
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said T. B. Snow

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us, the said

Trustees in hand well and truly paid by the said T. B. Snow

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said T. B. Snow

all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate
lying and being in Greenville County and State
aforesaid near the town of Greer on the west
side of South Trade street and having the follow-
ing meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at
an iron pin on the side of the road about
twelve feet from a stone and running thence
S. 14 E. 7.32 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 72.40 E.
3.16 2/3 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 13.30 W. 6.05 chs.
to an iron pin; thence N. 82 W. 3.16 2/3 chs. to the
beginning corner, and containing two acres more
or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed
to us by T. B. Snow by deed bearing date of
Sept. 10th 1918.
