interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent (10%)

bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever

situate in Gant Township in the County and
State aforesaid, containing one and one
half (36 1/2) acres more or less, having the
following metes and bounds to wit: beginning
at a maple 34' on the S. side of Saluda River (McGee
corner) and running N. 73° 30' E. 17.38 to a
stone 34'; thence N. 11° E. 48.80. A persimmon 34';
thence S. 72 1/2 W. 30.00 to a corner on Saluda
River; thence down said river to the beginning
corner; this being the same tract of land conveyed
