WHERERAS, I, the said C. P. Mayfield,
in and by my certain provisionary note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

Planted Savings Bank,
in the full and just sum of Eleven Thousand and One Hundred Dollars,
Dollars, to be paid December 25th, one thousand eight hundred and ten years,

day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ten years,
with interest thereon from the day of mortgage, Hughes' Battle,
computed and paid one thousand eight hundred and ten years,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent,

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Planted Savings Bank,

all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land known as lot #3 of the house place, situate lying and being on both sides of Pelham road in the County and State aforesaid Beginning at a stone on East side of said Pelham road and running thence S. 48⁰³' 4" W. 41. 80 chs. to stone 34; thence N. 11 W. 10. 00 chs. to Dogwood; thence N. 81 E. 24. 00 chs. to stone 34; thence S. 88 E. 16. 23 chs. to stone 34; thence S. 1 W. 6. 45 chs. to stone 34 the beginning corner and containing thirty-seven and two fifths (37 $\frac{2}{5}$) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of G. W. Smith, W. G. Mayfield, J. Thomas Vaughan and William Hendrix Est. and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Mrs. A. Mayfield et al by deed bearing date of Feb. 18th 1911 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 38 page 314. Also all that tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid adjoining lands of C. P. Mayfield, J. T. Vaughan and others, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: beginning at a stone 34⁰³' 2" and running thence N. 2⁰ 3' W. 20. 25 to a stone 34⁰³' 2" on the Mayfield line; thence N. 77 W. 6. 50 to a stone N. M. on said line; thence S. 2⁰ 3' E. 12. 10 chs. to a stone 34⁰³' 2" on the Mayfield line; thence S. 46 E. 9. 50 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing ten and one half (10 $\frac{1}{2}$) acres more or less; and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J. J. Rodgers by deed bearing date of December 5th 1918.
