interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing that an attorney in fact of the holder hereof, who may

bargain, sell and release unto the said H.S. Stokes, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land

situate, lying and being in Highland Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone on the Jordan Road and running thence N. 74-1/4 E. 1.78 to a stone; thence with the G.W. Waldrop line S. 31 E. 16.00 to a stone; thence with the Donalson line N. 87 W. 22.10 to a Hickory tree on Jordan Road; thence with said road 8.03 to the beginning corner, and containing twenty-one (21) acres, more or less.
Also, four (4) acres of land on the east side of the Jordan Road adjoining the above described land.
Also, all that parcel or tract of land on the Jordan Road and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning on a stone and running thence S. 71-1/2 W. to an iron pin; thence N. 19-1/2 W. 9.97 to a stone; thence N. 78-3/4 E. to a stone; thence down the Jordan Road 8.03 to the beginning corner and containing five (5) acres, more or less, adjoining the above described land and also lands of P.J.
