in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Four Hundred Dollars \$400.00  
Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not then when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the amount due upon this note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

*Miss Lillie Richards*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said

*J. W. J. Tucker*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Miss Lillie Richards*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Miss Lillie Richards*

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being a portion of the said lot on Bankhead Street, sub-divided.

Beginning at an iron pipe at corner of Wilson and Goodwin Streets, and running thence N. 69-58 E. on line of Goodwin Street 100 feet to another pipe; thence N. 16-46 W. 55 feet to an iron pipe, line of lot 920.10; thence with line of lots 920.9 and 10.8. 69-58 W. 100 feet to an iron pipe in Wilson Street; thence with line of said street S. 16-46 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner and being designated as lot 920.9, according to a plat made by G. E. Dalton, December, 1916 and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by John B. Marshall, by deed dated January 13th, 1919 and not yet recorded.
