Creek being all my interest in real estate on
the South Side of Beaverdam Creek.

Beginning on a stone on bank of Beaverdam
Creek running thence South course to a stone Thos.
Lindsey line, thence North East to stone, thence
to Beaverdam Creek to a stone, thence up said
Creek to stone the beginning corner, containing
thirty-two (32) acres more or less, and bounded by
lands of Thos. Lindsey, P. L. Lindsey and J. P. Petty.
