the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

of Oreal and Rhett Streets, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit: - Beginning at said
corner, and running thence with Oreal Street, S.
19- $\frac{1}{2}$ seventy-two and one-half (72- $\frac{1}{2}$) feet to an iron
pin; thence N. 40- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. sixty-four (64) feet to an iron
