in the full and just sum of Three thousand dollars
Dollars, to be paid in equal annual instalments of five hundred
dollars each year and two years from date

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, interest not when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said L. H. Littlefield all that certain parcel

and lot of land situate and being in the said State
and County, in the town of Greer, on the south side
of Mayfield Street, having the following meets and
boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the south
side of the said Street, corner of the E. J. Pennington
Lot, and runs thence with said Street, N. 55 1/2 W. 118 feet
to a stake; thence S 33 3/4 W. 114 feet to a stake; thence S.
54 1/2 E. 102 feet to stake on the line of the E. J. Pennington
lot; thence N. 33 3/4 E. 109 feet to the beginning corner,
and being the same lot this day conveyed to me by
L. H. Littlefield by deed. This note secured by this
